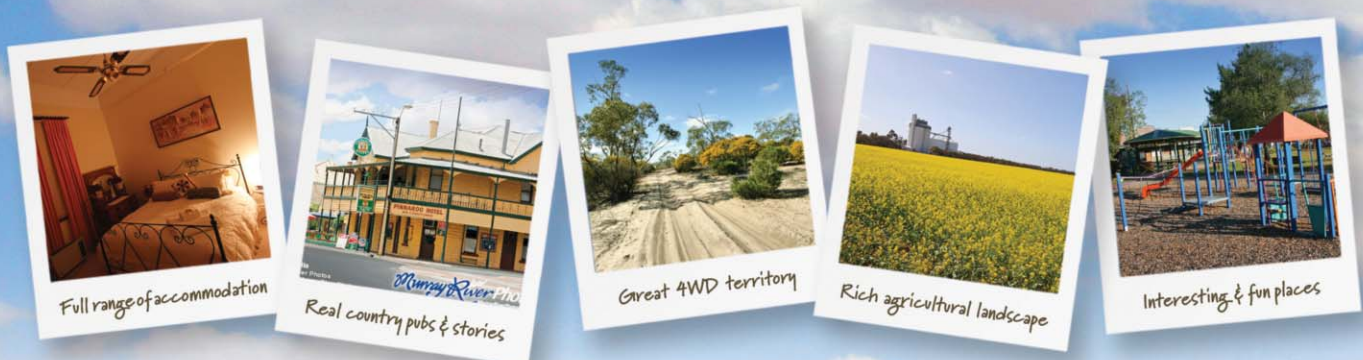


Mallee Highway Touring Route

To protect Australia's horticultural industry, there are fruit and vegetable restrictions across state borders. You may not enter these areas or cross state borders with tropical and temperate fruits (including mangos, avocados, grapes and berries), pome fruits (such as apples, pears and quince), citrus fruits, stone fruits (including apricots and peaches) and fruiting vegetables such as capsicums, chillies, eggplants, tomatoes and tamarillos. Disposal bins are provided near Pinnaroo entering SA for unwanted fruit and vegetables. On the spot fines apply. Visit fruitfly.net.au

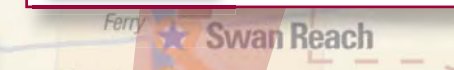

Did you know that the Mallee produces 65% of South Australia's white washed potatoes. Visit Pinnaroo's Bi-annual Spudfest in April.



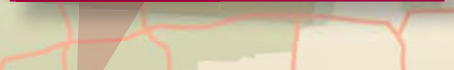
Pinnaroo Printing Museum

Julie Anthony is one of Australia's celebrated entertainers. She co-sang the Australian National Anthem at the 2000 Sydney Olympics.



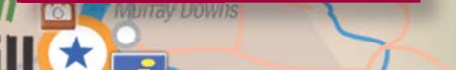
Explore Peake's history
